Chaplain Certificate Training Track

Monthly: 4 Hours of Classroom Instruction (8am-12pm), + 4 Hours of Practical Service
*Held on the **Second Saturday** of each month*

Weekly: 4 Hours of Self-Preparation and Study

Community Chaplain Certificate Courses

1. *The Basics of Chaplaincy (TBOC)*
2. *Christian Grief Counseling (CGC)*
3. *Healing the Wounds of Trauma (HWT)*
4. *Advanced Chaplain Skills (ACS)*
5. *Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM)*
6. *Community Chaplaincy Competencies (CCC)*

Cost: \$1000, plus one-time Application fee of \$75 (or \$100/month for 10 months or \$1000 if paid in full at beginning of class). All training books and materials are included.

1. Complete the online application at – www.idahoca.org/upcoming-trainings CLICK **Sign up for Training button**.
 - a. An application fee of \$75 is due with your application – CLICK **Pay Training Fees button**
2. Once your application is approved, you will be sent a password to the STUDENT PORTAL.
 - a. Your training fee is due when your application is approved – CLICK **Pay Training Fees button**
3. Once training fee is paid, you will receive instructions and code to register on the CC&C website and begin *The Basics of Chaplaincy* and the *Christian Grief Counseling* online courses.
4. Upon completion of these courses, you must pay your annual dues to CC&C of \$130 (\$100/year if paid through ICA)
5. The annual continuing education credit requirements are explained in TBOC. Your endorsement fee covers BOTH courses required by CC&C, (but not annual dues) and includes access to ICA Certification Training Units 3-6 and monthly meetings.
6. **NOTE: If enrolling in Fall 2022 – all CC&C courses must be completed before 12/31/2022, as new CC&C courses and requirements will become active on 1/1/2023.**
