Idaho Chaplains Association Qualifications and Requirements

Commitment to Christ.

A candidate for the chaplaincy program must be a Christian with a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

Commitment to a Christian Lifestyle.

A candidate for the chaplaincy program must be a representative of Jesus Christ both in their public and private life. This includes: basic knowledge of the Scriptures, emotional and spiritual maturity, emotional stability, healthy interpersonal relationships, financial responsibility and a stable living situation.

Commitment to ICA.

A candidate for the chaplaincy program must agree with ICA's Ministry Vision, Mission Statement, Statement of Faith, purpose and values.

Commitment of Time.

The amount of time required to complete the chaplaincy program. This includes time spent in the classroom, time required to complete homework assignments, and time spent serving.

Commitment to Teamwork and Assigned Duties.
